 - b. Go to the draft of the poem you wrote based on this week's mini-lesson. **Copy and paste your final stanza** into the Padlet post.
 - c. Write about which of the 7 endings you tried in your own poem draft.
 - d. Which ending did you choose? Why? How was it different and/or better than the others you tried? Be specific -- not just "It sounded the best" -- how did it help you achieve your purpose in your poem?
3. Then, comment on two other posts by building connections. You might discuss:
 - a. What connections do you see between your final stanza and your classmates'? In terms of technique? In terms of subject?
 - b. What connections do you see between your friends' final stanza and other poems we have read in this unit?
 - c. What do you love about their writing?
 - d. What do you see in a friends' post that you would want to try in a poem yourself?
